



Mustang Powder Small Groups, Steep Chutes (SGSC) Mandate

Our SGSC program is built for fit, expert skiers and riders seeking big-mountain thrills. You'll spend most days in the cat—but be ready for short boot-packs or skin tracks to reach tighter, technical lines.

Group Structure

- **Size:** 6 guests + 2 guides
- **Pace:** Small groups of strong skiers/riders move faster and more efficiently through complex terrain

What to Expect

- **Terrain & Run Selection:** Obscure, unique and sporty lines. When conditions allow, expect steep chutes and committing lines which may include cliffs, occasionally mandatory.
- **Potential to Tour:** this is **not** a touring trip, and touring is rare, but all guests must be prepared for short tours/boot-packs (typically 30 min or less; Under certain conditions, longer touring adventures do happen, to explore seldom visited locations

Guest Requirements

- **Expert Ski/Board Skills**
 - Confident linking short turns on steep, variable snow
 - Comfortable negotiating cliff features and tight entries
 - Strong powder skiing
 - Be prepared to sit out if you are unable to keep pace with the group or handle the terrain.
- **Physical Fitness**
 - Excellent cardiovascular and muscular endurance to handle back-to-back steep runs and the occasional boot-pack/tour

Gear Checklist & Safety

We have touring skis and skins available for guest use; however, you are welcome to bring your personal touring gear if you prefer

- **Skis:** Tyrolia Adrenalin alpine-touring bindings (compatible with any boot)
- **Snowboards:** Splitboards available via [Revelstoke Powder Rentals](#)—please arrange rentals directly
- **Safety Kit:** Avalanche Airbag, shovel, probe, beacon & radio provided by Mustang Powder
- **Etiquette:** Follow guide instructions without hesitation and be prepared to sit out if you are below standard
